**Library Access and Use Policy**

The Julien and Virginia Cornell Law Library is a private law library serving the research and educational needs of the Vermont Law School students, faculty, staff, alumni, Friends of the Library members, and others who demonstrate a need to use law library materials; and, as such, general public access to the Cornell Law Library is restricted. We reserve the right to request identification to verify status of all users. We reserve the right to restrict access to non-VLS users during exam periods, times of increased library demand by the VLS community, and for other reasons as required.

**The Cornell Library reserves the right to deny library privileges, including access, to any patron who, for example:**

- Fails to show appropriate identification when requested.
- Fails to show a demonstrated need to use law library materials.
- Fails to respect the rights of other patrons.
- Fails to respect library property.
- Fails to follow the library's written policies and rules set forth in library publications.

This policy is not intended to replace any existing VLS campus wide policies.
