All morning examinations begin at 9:00 a.m.; all afternoon examinations at 2:00 p.m. The length of an examination is usually equivalent to the number of credits, e.g., 3 credits = 3 hours.

*Vermont Law School Examination Rule:* A one exam per day policy is reasonable. If two examinations are scheduled on one day, the option will be to take the examination of the lower enrollment course, if not at the regular time, on the first day following the scheduled day when that person is not taking another examination. If this results in three examinations on **consecutive days**, or your original schedule produced the same result, you may also request to postpone one of these. (Take-home examinations which cover the entire examination period are not considered to be in conflict.) Please pick up a form requesting this option at the Registrar's Office as soon as possible and return no later than 5:00 p.m., Thursday, April 29. **Students are otherwise expected to take their examinations at the assigned time.**
