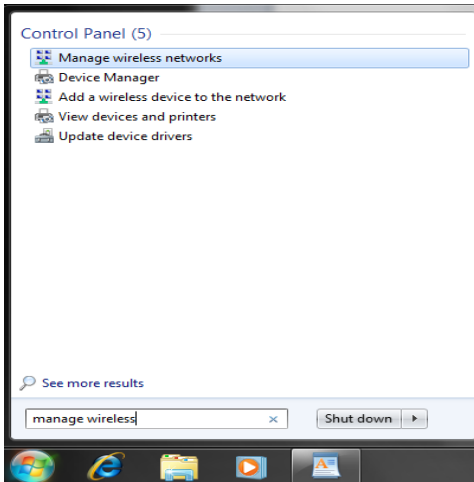
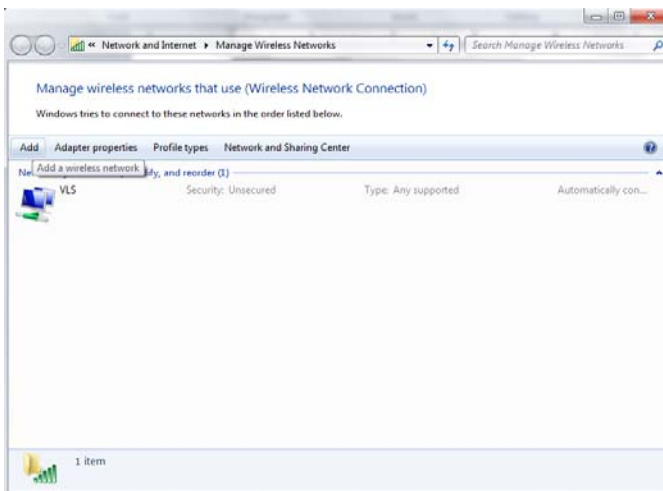


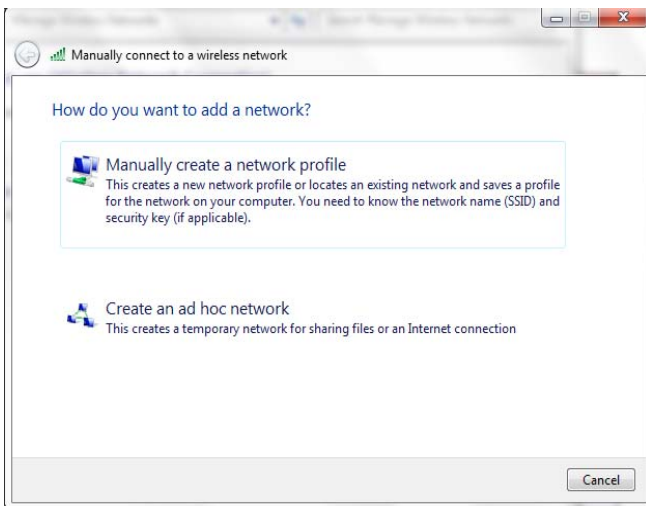

Click the start (Windows Icon) button, type in a search for **Manage Wireless Networks** and hit enter. Open **Manage Wireless Networks**

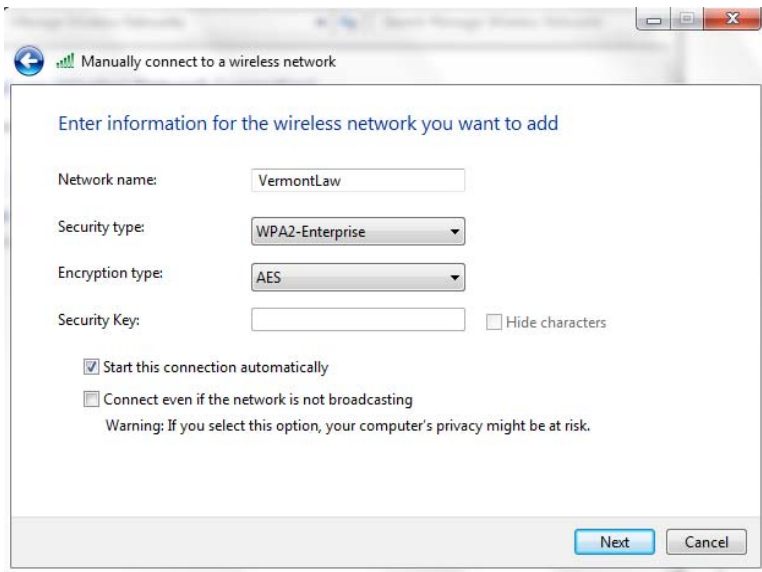


Click **Add**

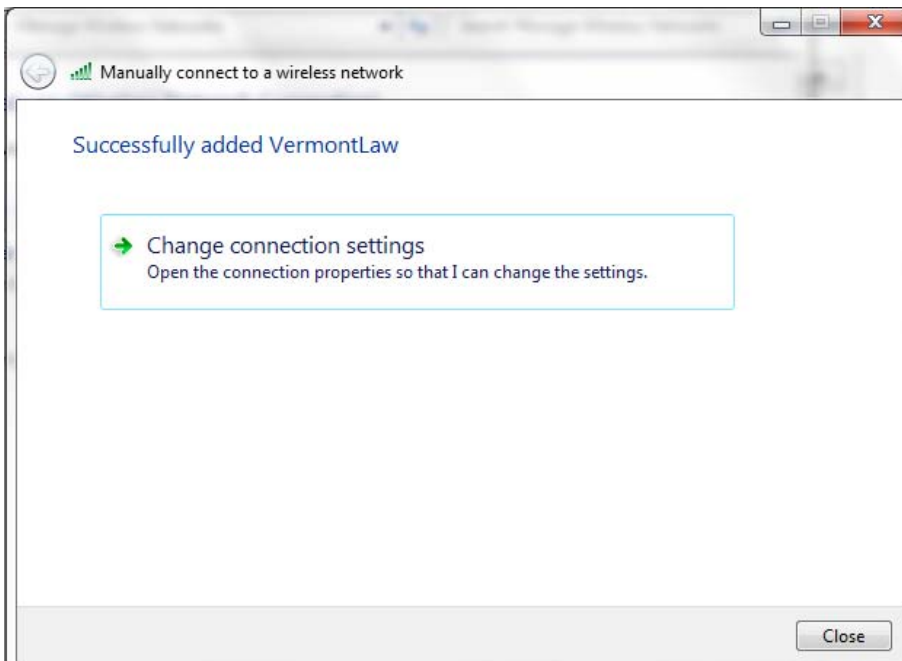


Enter the following information:

**Encryption type:** AES

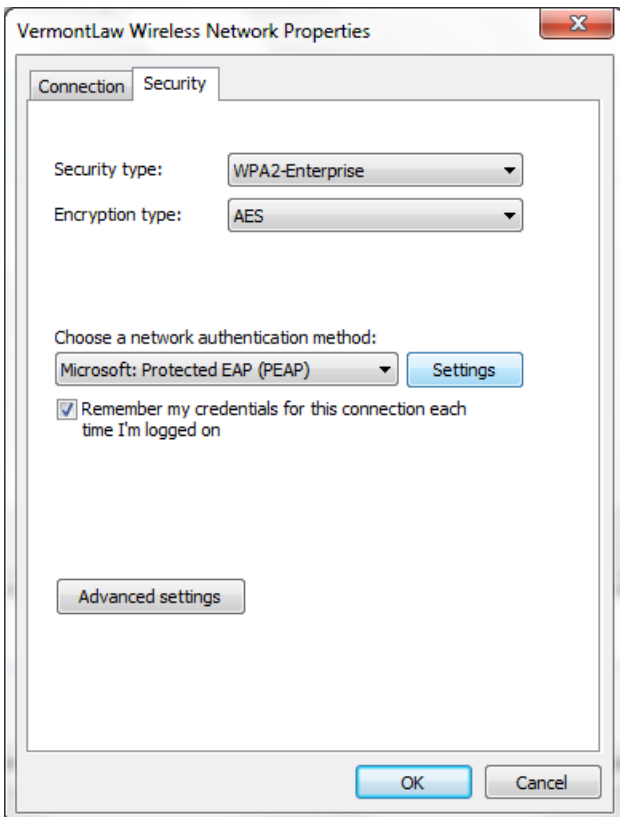
Leave **Security key:** blank.

Click **Next**

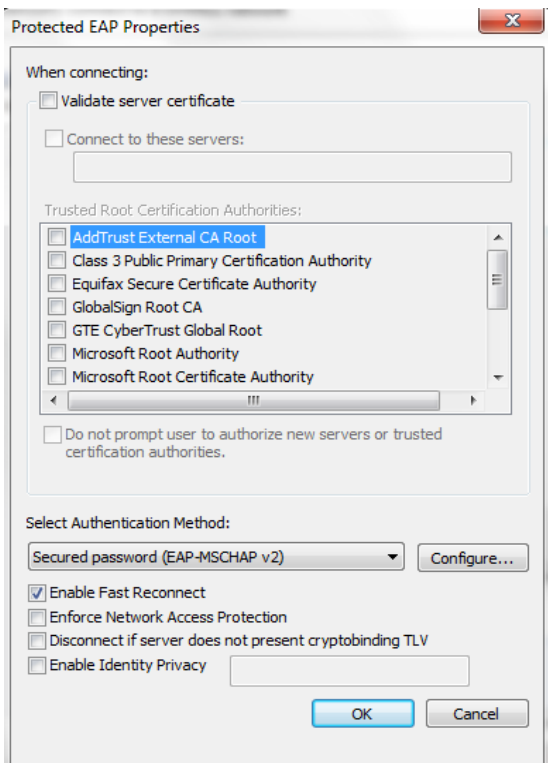

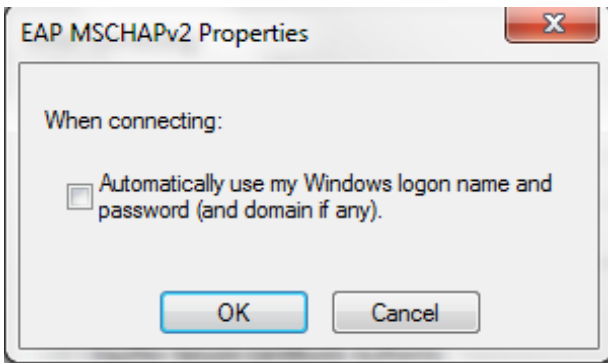


Click the **Security** tab, then click **Settings**

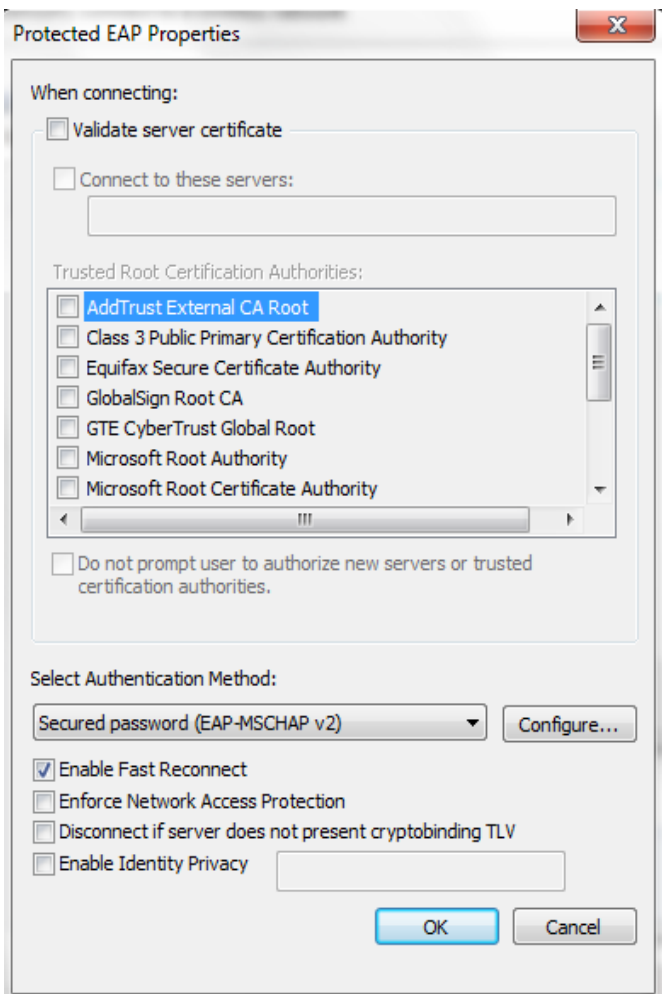


Uncheck **Validate server certificate**, then click **Configure**

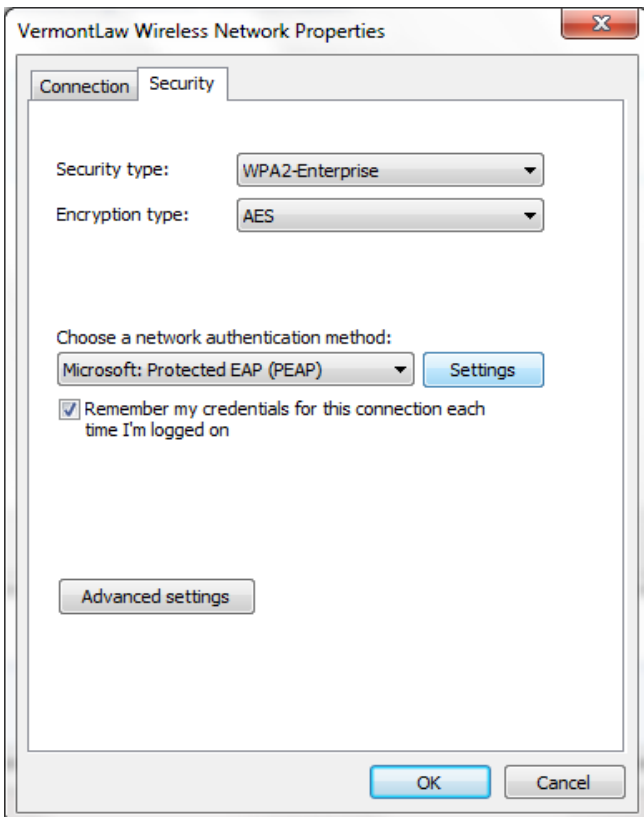


Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password**, then click **OK**

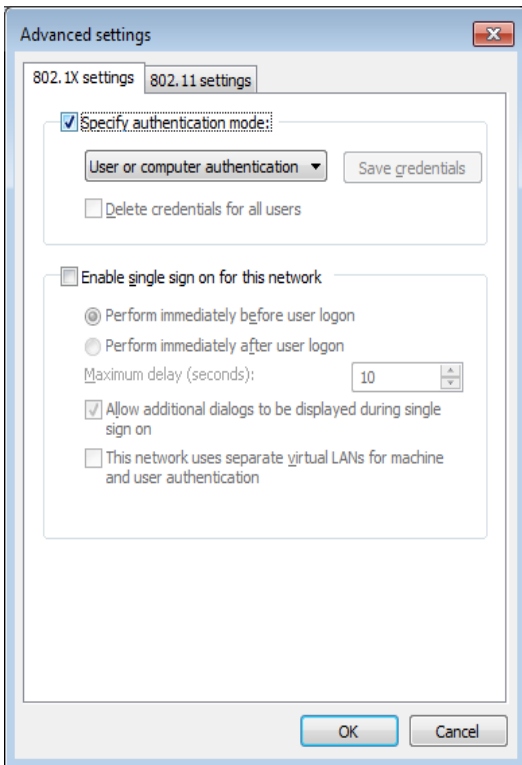

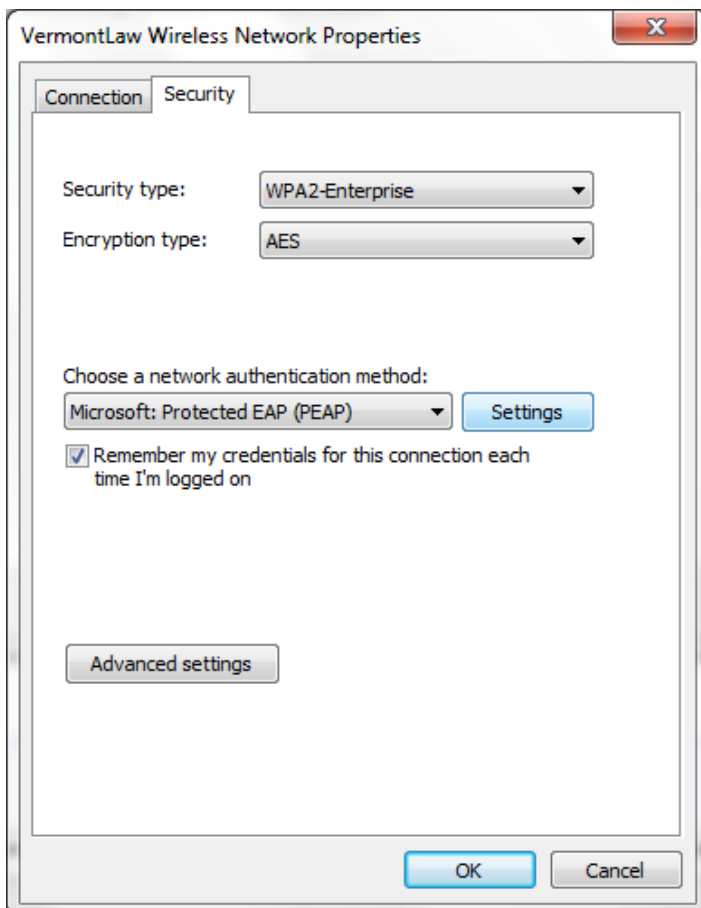


Click the **Advanced Settings** button

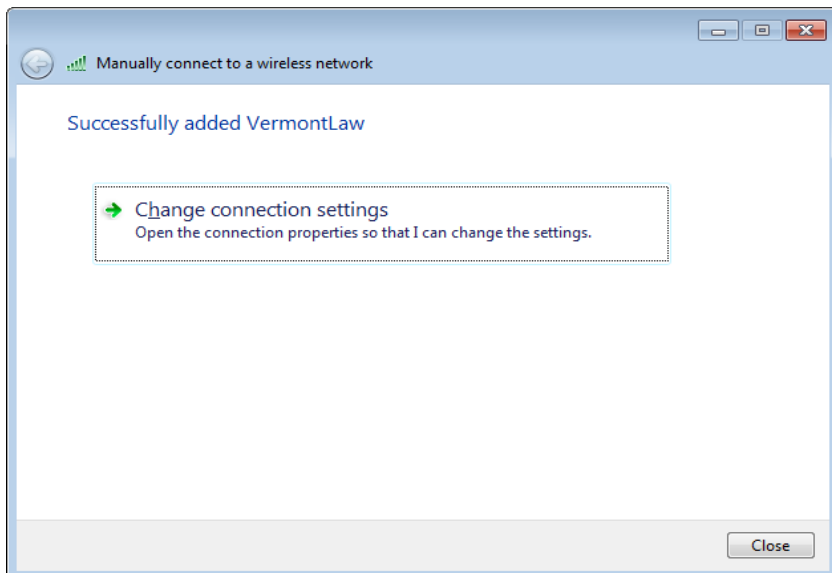


Put a checkmark in the box entitled **Specify authentication mode**, and ensure that the authentication mode is set to **User or computer authentication**. Click **OK**

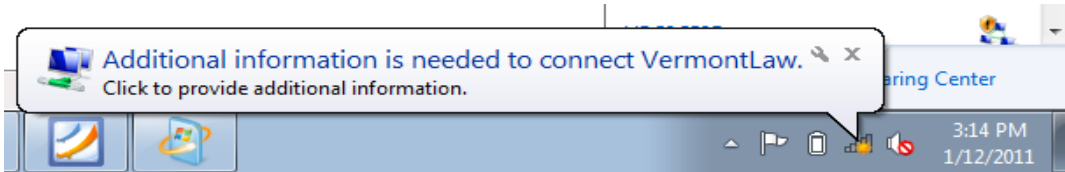


Click **OK**

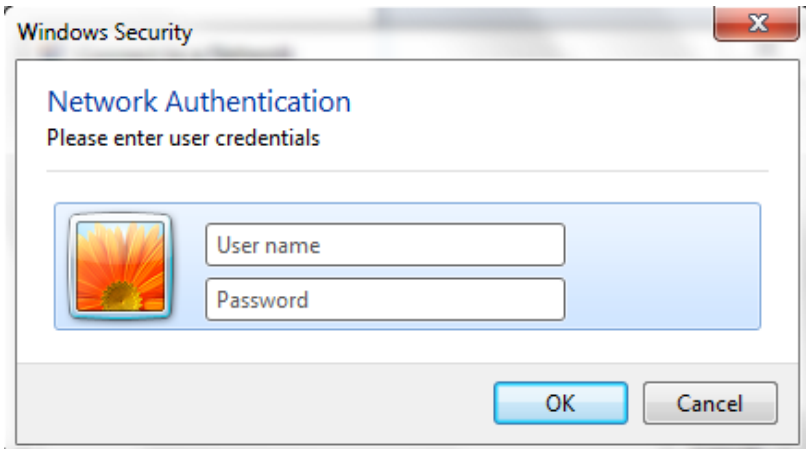

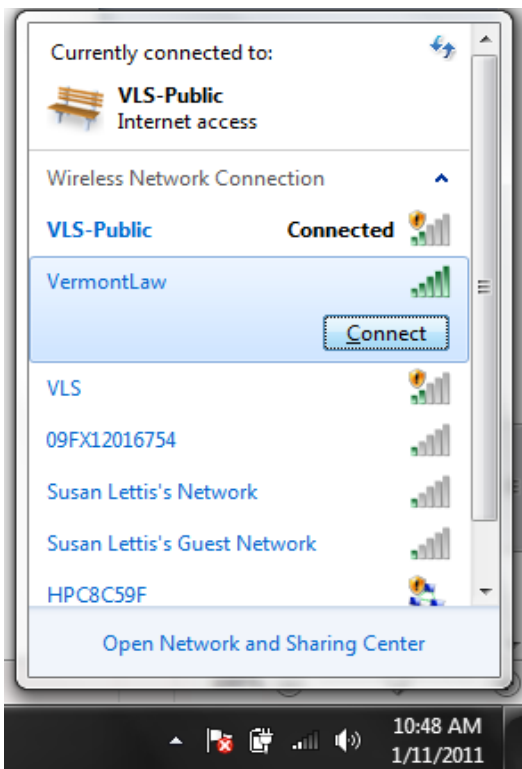
## VermontLaw Wireless Instructions for Windows 7
