

## Vermont Law School – Non Allowable Charges Authorization

Federal regulations permit schools to automatically apply a student's Federal Title IV Financial aid funds (Stafford Loans, Graduate Plus Loans, Perkins Loans) to tuition, fees, room and board charges. In addition, with the student's authorization title IV funds may be applied to a student's other cost of attendance charges which are billed by VLS through separate invoicing, such as costs for library fines, emergency loan repayments, parking fines, book replacement charges, computer software charges, new computer charge, health insurance charge, etc. Please note that your decision regarding the use of Federal financial aid funds will remain on file in the Student Accounts office, and that you may change it at any time by notifying us in writing.

**FAILURE TO PROVIDE AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FEDERAL TITLE IV FUNDS TO OTHER CHARGES WILL DELAY YOUR REFUND FOR LIVING EXPENSES.**

### Student Authorization
