Students will demonstrate an ability to engage in detailed legal research and writing by an in-depth exploration of an aspect of criminal law to satisfy the writing component of the certificate. Each certificate recipient will meet at least three times with the faculty coordinator: first, for a discussion and signing of the declaration form, next for a review and critique of the required writing submission, and lastly for the final approval of the certificate. These meetings will provide an opportunity for mentoring and discussions about career goals and professionalism.
