TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS

Unofficial Transcripts: To request a PDF copy of your unofficial transcript for job applications, log into VLSConnect (see above) and complete the transcript request form. You will receive the PDF through your VLSConnect email address.

Official Transcripts: To request an official transcript, go to <u>GetMyTranscript.org</u> and then click on "Order-Track-Verify" to place your order. The fee is \$5.00 per transcript, plus charges if expedited shipping is requested.

RECIPROCITY POLICY

Many law schools provide access to their career resources for students and graduates from other law schools that agree to provide similar services. This agreement is called reciprocity.

For VLS Graduates: If you are seeking a reciprocity agreement with a law school outside of Vermont in order to access geographic-specific career resources, please note that each law school has its own reciprocity requirements. If you are interested in requesting reciprocity with another law school, please review that law school's reciprocity requirements, and then email Shelly Parker to start the process.

For Non-VLS Graduates: The Office of Career Services provides access to its resources to students and alumni of law schools other than VLS as follows:

- 1. Services are limited to students and alumni of those schools that allow VLS students and alumni to use their career services facilities.
- 2. Requests for services must be made in advance, in writing, by a career services officer.
- 3. Services will be unavailable during the fall interview season.
- 4. Available services include: current vacancy announcements, access to library resources, and limited counseling—based on staff availability.
- 5. Unavailable services include: mail-merge services and access to the oncampus interviewing process.
- 6. All reciprocity decisions will be made on an individual basis, and the Director reserves the right to cancel the reciprocity privileges of any individual.
