### **Things that make me Grumpy**

### **Learning Outcomes**

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1) Demonstrate knowledge of the the structure and application process for the bar exam in your jurisdiction by completing “My Bar Exam” Information Sheet
- 2) Develop the skills to answer bar style multiple choice and essay questions through completing practice questions with feedback

- 3) Test understanding of highly tested substantive areas through completing practice questions with feedback
- 4) Create study tools that you will be able to use during bar study
- 5) Devise a plan for creating the time and structure needed to succeed on the bar exam through completion of summer calendar and review of bar prep company schedule

This course is **NOT A SUBSTITUTE FOR A COMMERCIAL BAR COURSE**. A commercial bar course requires about 600 hours of work in the 10 weeks leading up to the bar. This course is not intended to teach you all of the material you need for the bar exam. Rather, it is intended to give you a head start on bar study and give you the skills needed to take full advantage of your commercial bar prep course.

### **Commercial Bar Course Enrollment**

Four bar prep companies table in the Chase Breezeway on Thursdays. Stop by and sign up for one of their courses. Each company often has discounts going on, so be sure to ask and negotiate! These companies often have public interest rates that many VLS students will qualify for. I will share information about the public interest rates when I get updated information for this year. When you pay for your bar prep course, you will get access to the bar prep company's materials. While these materials are not a required component of this course, they can be a handy supplement.

### **Course Materials**

#### **Required Texts:**

Clearing the Last Hurdle, 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition, Wanda Temm (2017) – ISBN: 9781454892250. This book will be used for class instruction and many assignments will be drawn from this book. This book can be bought from the bookstore or directly from the publisher. Be sure to get the correct edition as some of the materials have changed. Notably, the new edition has more civil procedure material since civil procedure was not an MBE subject until 2014.

Strategies & Tactics for the MBE, 6<sup>th</sup> Edition, Steven Emanuel (2016) – ISBN: 9781454873129. This book contains approximately 600 additional officially licensed MBE questions. Many of the questions and explanations for multiple choice problems will be taken from this book. Some copies may be available used online, however be sure you are getting the correct edition. Prior editions do not have any Civil Procedure questions since that was just added to the MBE in 2014.

### **Additional Materials:**

Additional materials are posted on TWEN. I created lessons for the online version of this class, and all of those materials are also available to you on TWEN. Videos explaining the rules for all MBE homework assignments and MBE quizzes are also on TWEN. You will get access to these videos when you upload your answers and autopsy sheets. Classes will be recorded and posted to TWEN. You will have access to these during the semester and during bar study. Listening to recordings is not a substitute for class attendance. The TWEN page for this class is “Bar Exam Skills & Tactics (BEST) FALL 2018”.

### **Recommended Materials:**

Critical Pass Cards: <https://criticalpass.com>. These flash cards are a great study tool, especially if you are a visual learner. They contain black letter law for the 7 MBE subjects and space for you to take additional notes. I highly recommend them. If you get them now, you can start to compile additional rules from this class on the cards for your use during bar study.

Lean Sheets: <http://www.leansheets.com>. These outlines are also a great study tool. They contain black letter law in condensed format for all UBE subjects.

Commercial Bare Prep Company Materials: As soon as you pay for your commercial bar prep course, you will get access to many of those course materials. Those materials are not required for this course, but you can use them as a supplement.

The other half of your grade is based on a final exam. The final exam will consist of 34 multiple-choice questions. ***I will only use questions that you have already seen on a quiz or homework assignment on the final.*** On the bar exam, you will have 1 hour to complete 34 questions. For this final exam, I will give you 2 hours.

All assignments are due by the date on the syllabus or TWEN unless you are otherwise told by me. Usually homework assignments are due at 5 p.m. or 11:59 p.m. the day prior to class. Quizzes and other assignments completed in class are usually due by 11:59 p.m. of the day of class. If any of these assignments are not completed by the assigned time (or are completed in a manner not satisfactory to the professor), it is at the professor's discretion to determine if and how the student can make up the required work. Additionally, all students must comply with the attendance policy below and be ready and prepared to participate in each class. Quality of work, timeliness of all work, class participation, and attendance will all be factored in determining your grade for the course.

### **Attendance Policy**<sup>1</sup>

Attendance is mandatory for this class. A student will be counted as absent if he/she is not present within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time of the class. A student will be considered late if he/she arrives to class after attendance is taken, but prior to 10 minutes after the scheduled start time of class. If you are late twice, that counts as one absence. If a student misses more than 5 classes, that student will fail the course due to absence. The professor reserves the right to

award positive or negative class participation points based on timely class attendance and participation. You will be responsible for all material covered in any class you miss and may be required to complete make-up work at the professor's discretion.

Absences resulting from serious illness, religious observance, and/or significant personal emergency may be considered excused if you give notice prior to the class you must miss. However, prior notice of an absence does not automatically qualify your absence as "excused." This will be assessed on a case by case basis and will only be granted in extraordinary circumstances. The presumption is that an absence will not be excused and will count to one of your 5 permitted unexcused absences. Examples of circumstances that may warrant an excused absence are hospitalization, death in the family, or the like.

### **Weather**

If the school is closed, class is cancelled for that day and will be rescheduled. If the school is open, but travel is not safe from where you are coming, exercise your discretion. If you are not able to attend due to weather, inform the professor as soon as possible. Again, prior notice of an absence due to weather does not automatically qualify your absence as "excused" and will be assessed on a case by case basis. It is situations like this that we have the 5 permitted unexcused absences.

### **Syllabus**

The professor reserves the right to amend or change this syllabus at any time as needed throughout the semester. The syllabus is a helpful guide intended to give you an overview of the course, but is subject to be changed or supplemented at the professor's discretion. Please take the time to read and review this syllabus in detail.
