

# Vermont Law School International & Comparative Law Program

Semesters Abroad	
<b>McGill University</b>	Located in the diverse cultural center of Montreal, McGill is an ideal location to develop an understanding of common and civil law. The law faculty also specializes in human rights law and space law. Courses are offered in both English and French.
<b>University of Trento</b>	One of Europe's leading schools for European Union and Comparative Law, Trento is surrounded by the beautiful Dolomite Mountains. Courses are available in English, German, and Italian.
<b>CY Cergy Paris Université</b>	A modern University of Paris law faculty, located in western suburbs, CY Cergy offers LLM courses in French and European Law with all courses taught in English. Students can live in Paris and commute via metro.
<b>University Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne</b>	One of the original University of Paris law faculties, Paris 1 offers a wide array of courses, including in international and European Union Law. Must have language proficiency to take courses in French.
Courses with Study Abroad Component	
<b>European Union Law-Trento</b> -Trento, Italy	Spend Fall Break in Italy learning from EU law experts at the University of Trento, as a one-credit addition to European Union Law course held on campus. Topics may include anti-terrorism and human rights, environmental law, social conflicts in the EU single market, and police-judicial cooperation in criminal matters.
<b>International Climate Change Law</b>	This three-credit course allows students to do applied learning in international climate change law by representing the Vermont Law School on our COP26 Observer Delegation. The course is organized around two components: a weekly class for the full semester and one week of on-site experiential learning at the Conference of Parties (COP). <b>**COP26 has been postponed until 2021**</b>

## International Dual Degrees

<b>University of Cambridge</b>	JD/MPhil in Environmental Policy; Real Estate Finance; or Planning, Growth, and Regeneration. Four semesters at VLS, then one year at the University of Cambridge, then fifth semester at Vermont Law School.
<b>CY Cergy Paris Université</b>	JD/Masters I & II in Business Law, Business Ethics, or International & European Economics. Students spend two years at VLS and up to two years at CY Cergy Paris Université. All courses are taught in French. Upon completion of Master II, individuals are eligible to take the Paris Bar and then practice throughout the European Union.
	JD/LLM in French and European Union Law. Two years at VLS, one year at CY Cergy. All courses are taught in English.

<b>International and Comparative Law Concentration</b>	Through coursework in international and comparative law and participation in a study abroad experience, students will be equipped with skills to compare and analyze legal systems and frameworks between countries.
